- 1. What is the school doing to prevent transmission of Covid 19?**
  - a) Protocol and mandatory measures to be adhered to by the all the staff and students.
  - b) Daily streaming and monitoring of absent students.

- 5. What do I do if my child has a fever or temperature above 37.5 or flu like symptoms?**

  - b) If symptoms persist, get medical attention
  
- 6. What do I do if my child tests positive for Covid 19?**
  - a) Keep the child at home for **14 days** and inform the school.
  - b) Isolate the child from the rest of the family and maintain containment measures.
  - c) Keep the siblings at home for **14 days**.
  - d) Provide psychological and emotional support to the child.



**7. A family member has covid 19. Should my child come to school?**

Your child may have been exposed.

He/she will take a covid 19 test then stay at home for **14 days**. A PCR negative test will be required before resuming school.

**8. What do I do if my child gets in contact with a covid 19 positive case outside family?**

- a) Let the child isolate for **7 days**.
- b) Take a PCR test before he/she resumes school.

**9. Is covid 19 vaccine important?**
