SUMMARY OF THE EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING
28 Janvier 2026



An Extraordinary General Meeting of the Parents' Association of the Lycée Français Denis Diderot of Nairobi was held on Wednesday, January 28, 2026, from 5:30 PM, in the presence of the Management Committee, the school's official members, and a representative of the French Embassy in Kenya.

1. Quorum

Participation included families present on-site, those attending remotely, and the proxies received. As the quorum required to formally hold an Extraordinary General Meeting in accordance with the Parents' Association's statutes was not reached, the meeting was held as a working session. In line with the statutes, an electronic vote was organized in the hours following the meeting to allow all eligible families to express their views on the proposed 2026 budget.

2. Message from the French Embassy

The representative of the French Embassy commended the community's commitment and emphasized the importance of parental participation in decision-making processes. He also highlighted ongoing developments within the AEFÉ network, as well as prospects for international cooperation involving the school.

3. Presentation of the 2026 Budget Forecast

The 2026 budget was presented in an economic context marked by:

- developments within the AEFÉ framework,
- inflation and currency fluctuations,
- the commitment to maintaining a high standard of educational quality.

The budgetary orientations are aligned with the school's strategic plan, particularly within the framework of the Vision 2030 initiative.

The presentation was followed by a question-and-answer session, during which families engaged with the Management Committee on the various components of the budget, investment projects, pricing policy, and the school's development outlook.

In accordance with the statutes, and in the absence of a quorum, an online vote was organized at the end of the meeting to allow families to express their position on the proposed budget for the 2025–2026 school year, showing a significant improvement in the school's financial position, with a surplus recorded in 2024.

4. Closing of the Meeting

The Chairperson closed the meeting. The Management Committee thanked all families for their participation and continued engagement within the school community.
